### QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

To achieve Certificate III in Beauty Services a total of 18 units must be completed

14 Core units

4 units

### DURATION & DELIVERY

This course is delivered as a competency based flexible learning program, the theory elements can be studied in a variety of options including, classroom based, delivered off the job or distance studies, the practical element are delivered in a simulated salon environment. It combines face to face teaching with individual or small group training, with units being completed in a specific time frame. Duration approximately 12-18 month's depending if the learner is full time or part time.

### RECOGNISED QULAIFICATIONS

Certificate III in Beauty Services (SHB30121) is a nationally recognised qualification. The program is structured in line with the National Hairdressing and Beauty Training Package (SIB15)

### CAREER PATHWAYS

Successful graduates from Certificate III in Beauty Services program can become self-employed, work as a junior beauty therapist specialising in waxing, tinting, manicure, pedicare and make-up or as a specialist in wedding or formal make-up.

### Eligibility and Special conditions

An individual cannot do two general pathway qualifications under Career Start.

Note: To be able to take advantage of Career Start funding you must enrol in the complete program

### **CAREER START provides individuals with the skills and support to start their career.**

To be eligible to access the Career Start, you must:

- Be aged 15 years old or over
- Be no longer at school
- Permanently reside in Queensland
- Be an Australian or New Zealand citizen or Australian permanent resident with the right visa and work permits on the pathway to permanent residency
- Not already have a certificate III level or higher qualification
- Not be currently enrolled in a certificate III level or higher course

### FEES

#### **Fees are structured into two (2) categories Non-concessional and Concessional.**

To be eligible for concessional student status student must fall into one of the following categories:

- Hold a Health Care, Veteran or Pensioner concession Card, or is the partner or dependant of a person who holds such card and is named on the card.
- Holds an official form issued under the commonwealth law confirming the above
- Identifies as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander
- Has a disability

#### **All evidence must be provided at time of enrolment**

The fees are structured so that all competencies include educational resources. Kits are required when enrolling in the corresponding practical unit. RPL, credit transfers or gap training can alter the total cost of the course. Refer to point 12 fees and Charges in Induction Manual
