## DURATION & DELIVERY

This course is delivered as a competency based flexible learning program, which the theory elements are delivered in a classroom environment or distance studies (meaning at home), the practical element are delivered in a simulated salon environment at LarShar College or in house salon training. This will all depend on each students individual circumstances. It combines face to face teaching with individual or small group training. Duration approximately 2-year full time
