DURATION & DELIVERY

This course for high school students is delivered as a two (2) year program, one day a week, broken down into terms and is as a competency based flexible learning program, the theory elements are classroom based, the practical element are delivered in a simulated salon environment at LarShar College. It combines face to face teaching with small group training, with units being completed in a specific time frame.

RECOGNISED QULAIFICATIONS

Certificate III in Beauty Services (SHB30121) is a nationally recognised qualification. The program is structured in line with the National Hairdressing and Beauty Training Package (SIB15)

CAREER PATHWAYS

Successful graduates from Certificate III in Beauty Services program can become self-employed, work as a junior beauty therapist specialising in waxing, tinting, manicure, pedicare and make-up or as a specialist in wedding or formal make-up.

FEES

The fees are a structured so that no kits are required for the relevant competencies being taught. All competencies include learner guides and relevant recourse. Make up brush set is included
