DURATION & DELIVERY

This course is delivered as a competency based flexible learning program, the theory elements can be studied in a variety of options including, class room based, delivered off the job or distance studies, the practical element are delivered in a simulated work environment. It combines face to face teaching with individual or small group training, with units being completed in a specific time frame.

RECOGNISED QULAIFICATIONS

Certificate III in Make-Up (SHB30221) is a nationally recognised qualification. The program is structured in line with the National Hairdressing and Beauty Training Package (SHB15).

CAREER PATHWAYS

This course is suitable for students wishing to enter the makeup sector of the beauty industry. Students completing this course will typically work as part of a team or on a freelance basis in settings such as make-up studios, retail cosmetic counters, fashion and media sets and photography studios.

Fees
